
### CHECK THE BRUSH AND THE **SQUEEGEE:**

Check that the brush and the squeegee are clean. Check the correct fixing of the brush and the squeegee rubbers.

#### PREPARE THE MACHINE:


## **VERTICAL POSITIONING OF** THE MACHINE:


## **CLEAN THE SQUEEGEE:**


Clean the rubbers and the suction inlet to remove eventual residuals of dirt.



#### **REMOVE AND CLEAN** THE BRUSH:


Rotate the brush clockwise until it is released. Clean with a water jet and reassemble it again.

# **SAFETY RULES**

- During the operation of the machine, pay attention to other people and especially to the children.
- Do not damage the mains cable by squashing or bending.
- Check the integrity of the mains cable and in case of damage, stop the machine and replace the cable.
- Do not use the machine on surfaces covered with inflammable liquids or dusts (for example hydrocarbons, ashes or soot).
- In case of fire do not use water but a powder based fire-extinguisher.
- During maintenance operation use suitable individual protection devices (gloves, glasses, shoes).
- Signal the areas of moist floors.

- Do not place any metallic tools onto the batteries. Risk of short circuit!
